I would like to thank you for the valuable contribution made by your institution during the past years of designation as a WHO collaborating centre. I am pleased to inform you that the World Health Organization has redesignated the Centre for Research and Training on Interprofessional Education, Gunma University, as a WHO Collaborating Centre for Research and Training on Interprofessional Education, under WHO's reference number JPN-89.
